

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

COST: \$30 per team with a \$50 maximum per school (no matter how many teams you send). Make checks payable to: CYO Athletic Board. Send it in with your roster by **Wednesday, January 25, 2017.** **TEAMS THAT DO NOT SUBMIT ENTRY FEES BY JANUARY 25 WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SCHEDULE.**

ROSTER: You must complete an enclosed roster for each team you are sending and return it to Chuck Cook at the address below **no later than Wednesday, January 25, 2016** (Players not listed on the roster will not be allowed to play so be sure you include everyone who will be or may be playing.) (Students serving as team managers, etc. who will be sitting on the bench should also be included on the roster with a special notation indicating their position with the team.) The Coach as well as either the School Principal or School Athletic Director must sign their names on the back of the roster.

ELIGIBILITY: Only players that regularly attend your school on a full time basis may participate. 20 players is the maximum allowed per roster. No one in a grade higher than 8th may play in the 7-8th grade division and no one in a grade higher than 6th may play in the 5-6th grade division. The 7-8th and 5-6th grade teams may include players from lower grades, for example 5th and 6th graders may play on a 7-8th grade team or 3rd and 4th graders may play on a 5-6th grade team, as long as they meet the minimum age requirements. Players may be on more than one roster, for example a 6th grader may be on both the 5-6th grade team and 7-8th grade team for a school. Only boys may play on boy's teams and only girls can play on a girl's teams.

AGE REQUIREMENTS:

7-8th Grade Maximum Age: If you turn 15 before Jan. 1, 2017, you are too old to play

7-8th Grade Minimum Age: If you turn 10 after Dec. 31, 2016 you are too young to play

5-6th Grade Maximum Age: If you turn 13 before Jan. 1, 2017, you are too old to play

5-6th Grade Minimum Age: If you turn 8 after Dec. 31, 2016, you are too young to play

COACHES: Coaches in this tournament DO NOT need to be ASEP certified.

THE BENCH: Only those coaches listed on this roster and players listed on this roster are to be seated on the team bench. Other adults, students, parents, etc. need to be sitting elsewhere.

FEDERATION BASKETBALL RULES: 2016 – 2017 National Federation Basketball Rules will be in effect for all games. The only addition is: there is a no full-court press rule for a team with a 20 point or higher lead.

DIOCESAN ATHLETIC BOARD: The Diocesan CYO Athletic Board directs this tournament on behalf of the Diocesan Catholic Schools Department. Standards of conduct and sportsmanship in keeping with Catholic values are thus expected and will be enforced for all players, coaches and spectators.
